

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LAMPMAN, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN,  
FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING THE LANE IN BLOCK 1, AS SHOWN ON  
REGISTERED PLAN NO. 78R03962.

WHEREAS notice was given by publication thereof in the  
PRAIRIE PROGRESS, a weekly newspaper circulating in the Town  
of Lampman, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in the issues of  
December 12th and December 19th, 1984, of the intention of the  
Council of the Town of Lampman to close the lane in Block 1 as  
shown on Registered Plan 78R03962 in the Town of Lampman.

AND WHEREAS the Minister of Highways and Transportation  
of the Province of Saskatchewan has consented to the said closing;

AND WHEREAS the provisions of Section 156 of The Urban  
Municipality Act have been fully complied with and no person  
has claimed that his land will be injuriously affected thereby,  
nor petitioned the Council to be heard in connection with this  
Bylaw;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Lampman, duly  
assembled, enacts as follows:

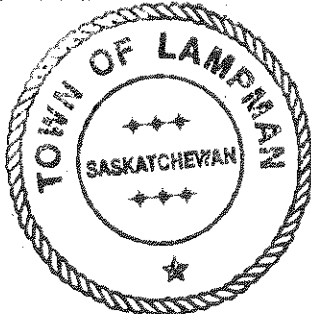
1. THAT the lane lying within the limits of Block 1, in  
the Town of Lampman, Province of Saskatchewan, Dominion  
of Canada, as said lane is shown on a Plan of Record in  
the Land Titles Office for the Regina Land Registration  
District as No. 78R03962, be closed.
2. THAT the Minister of Highways and Transportation for the  
Province of Saskatchewan be and is requested to convey  
title for the said lane as contained in Paragraph 1 hereof,  
to the Town of Lampman.

THIS BYLAW shall come into force and have effect from and  
after the final passing thereof.

READ a first time this 9th day of January, A.D., 1985.

READ a second time this 9th day of January, A.D., 1985.

READ a third time this 9th day of January, A.D., 1985,  
and passed with the unanimous consent of all members present.
