

BYLAW NO. 2014-7

**A Bylaw of the Town of Lampman, in the Province of Saskatchewan,
to Undertake the Construction of Curbing along 1st Avenue East
as a Local Improvement**

The Council of the Town of Lampman, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The undertaking of construction of curbing as a local improvement is hereby authorized on:

<u>Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
SE side 1 st Avenue East	Lot 1 Block 13 Plan 102011364 402 1 st Ave E	Lot 8 Block 13 Plan 10201136 412 1 st Ave E
NW side 1 st Avenue East	Lot 7 Block 12 Plan 75R23607 405 1 st Ave E	Lot 9 Block 12 Plan 75R23607 407 1 st Ave E

Project will consist of rolled curbing along 1st Avenue East south east side from Lot 1 to 8, Block 13, Plan 10201136 and the north west side from Lot 7 to 9 Block 12 Plan 75R23607.

2. The estimated cost of the undertaking is \$44,135.40; the estimated sum of \$0.00 is to be paid by the municipality and the estimated sum of \$44,135.40 is to be paid by the benefitting landowners by way of special assessment.
3. The estimated special assessment rate on a prepaid basis is \$255.00 per metre frontage. If not prepaid, the estimated special assessment rate to be paid during the years 2015 to 2019 inclusive is \$62.19 per metre frontage and will be payable as follows: payable in five (5) equal payment due by December 31 of each year.
4. The Mayor and Administrator are authorized to raise, by way of temporary loans or advances from any bank, credit union or person, the moneys necessary to meet the cost of the undertaking. Any such loans or advances shall be a first charge upon the proceeds of the sale of any debentures. The Mayor and the Administrator are authorized to sign and seal any promissory note, notes or renewals to effect such loans or advances.
5. The lifetime of the work described above, as estimated by the engineer, is 20 years.

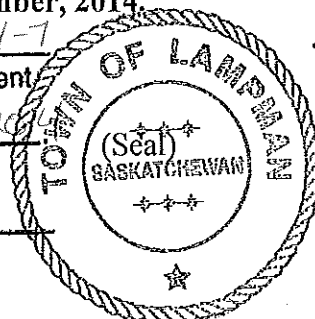
