

BYLAW NO. 3-92

A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER FROM THE MUNICIPALITY'S WATERWORKS SYSTEM.

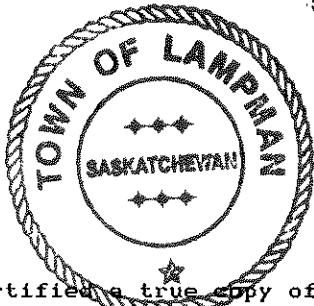
The council of the Town of Lampman, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


1. The Town of Lampman shall have the right to limit the amount of water furnished to any customer, should circumstances seem to warrant such action.
2. The use of water from the municipal system for the watering of lawns, trees, and gardens is hereby restricted as follows:
 - (a) All residents and business places NE of Main Street will be allowed to water lawns, trees and gardens every Monday and Thursday.
 - (b) All residents and business places in the triangle will be allowed to water lawns, trees, and gardens every Tuesday and Friday.
 - (c) All residents and business places South of Corrigan Road will be allowed to water lawns, trees, and gardens every Wednesday and Saturday.
3. No person shall convey, sell, dispose of or give away or permit water to be carried or taken away or use it or supply it for the use or benefit of others.
4. Any person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw which no other penalty is provided shall be guilty of an offence and liable upon summary conviction of penalties provided for under the general penalty bylaw of the Town of Lampman.
5. This bylaw shall come into effect immediately following passing.
