

## BYLAW NO. 2006-18

### **A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LAMPMAN TO CLASSIFY, REGULATE AND LICENCE ANY BUSINESS, TRADE OR CALLING NOT ASSESSABLE FOR THE PURPOSE OF TAXATION IN RESPECT TO THEIR BUSINESS, TRADE OR CALLING**

The Council of the Town of Lampman, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw the expression "transient trader" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by *The Municipalities Act*.
2. No person shall carry on any business, trade or calling set out in Section 9 of this Bylaw within the municipality unless he/she has in his/her possession a valid and subsisting licence for the purposes issued in accordance with the provisions of this Bylaw.
3. The Clerk/Administrator of the municipality is hereby authorized to issue a license to any person carrying on a business, trade or calling in the municipality:
  - (a) Who is not assessable by the municipality for the purposes of business taxation in respect to that business, trade or calling; and
  - (b) Who makes application for such licence stating specifically the nature of his/her business in the municipality; and
  - (c) Who tenders with his/her application the proper licence fee as provided for in Section 9.
4. Every licence issued under the authority of this Bylaw, unless suspended or revoked, shall expire on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December of the year of issue.
5. Where a licence is issued after the 1st day of September in any year, the fee payable under Section 9 shall be reduced by fifty (50%) percent.
6. Every licence issued shall specifically state the kinds of services, goods or merchandise which the licensee is authorized to offer for sale or take orders for as the case may be and whether in the case of goods or merchandise, he/she may offer the same for sale by retail or by public auction or both. Such licence shall also state the restriction as set forth in Section 7 hereof.
7. No person to whom a licence has been granted under this Bylaw shall offer for sale services, goods or merchandise or solicit orders for future delivery of goods or

merchandise within the town:

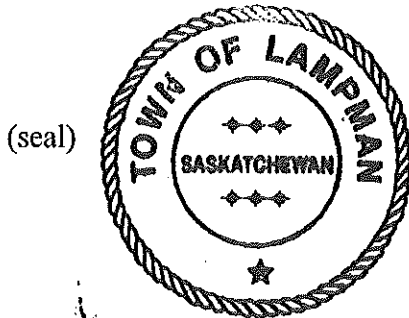
- ( a ) other than kind or kinds described in the licence; or
  - ( b ) by any method except as stated in the licence; or
  - ( c ) At any time or during any period when shops within the town offering for sale or taking orders for similar services, goods or merchandise are required by town Bylaw to be and remain closed.
8. Every person licenced under this Bylaw shall, at all reasonable times, upon request of the Clerk/Administrator, the bylaw enforcement officer or licence inspector, or any peace officer, produce such licence for inspection purposes.
9. Subject to Section 5, the fee payable for a licence under this Bylaw shall be as follows:
- ( a ) For a transient trader, One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars;
  - ( b ) For a contractor who enters into contracts for the construction, alteration, repair, or removal of buildings or structures, the installation of heating units, plumbing or other fixtures, electrical wiring, painting or performance of other similar work in the municipality, One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars;
  - ( c ) Unclassified business, trades, or other callings not specifically provided for in this Bylaw and which business, trade or calling is not assessable for the purpose of business taxation, Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars;
10. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and, upon conviction, shall be liable to a fine under the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
11. Bylaw No. 1985-6 is hereby repealed.

12. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.

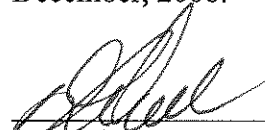
