- b. Arrange and pay for the maintenance or repair using the Landlord's contractors.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, if the maintenance or repair is occasioned due to misuse or negligence on the part of the Tenant, the Tenant shall be responsible for all costs associated with such maintenance or repair.

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Clause 95 as follows:

The Tenant will comply with standards of health, sanitation, fire, housing and safety as required by law.

BYLAW NO. 2024-04

BASE MUNICIPAL TAX

A Bylaw to Authorize the Use of a Base Municipal Tax

The Council of the Town of Lampman, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

Pursuant to Section 290(1) of *The Municipalities Act*, a Base Municipal Tax shall be applied to properties in the Town of Lampman as follows:

1. A Base Municipal Tax of Eight hundred eighty (\$80.00) dollars shall be applied to the following classes of properties assessed for land and improvements in addition to the assessment times the established mill rate for each year:

Residential Commercial and Industrial Agriculture

- 2. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.
- 3. Bylaw No. 2022-5 is hereby repealed.

BYLAW NO. 2024-05

MILL RATE FACTORS

A Bylaw to Authorize the Use of Mill Rate Factors

The Council of the Town of Lampman, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Pursuant to Section 285 (1) of *The Municipalities Act*, mill rate factors shall be established to properties in the Town of Lampman as follows:

- 1. A mill rate factor of 1.0 shall be applied to the uniform mill rate for all residential classes of property in the Town of Lampman.
- 2. A mill rate factor of 1.0 shall be applied to the uniform mill rate for all agricultural classes of property in the Town of Lampman.
- 3. A mill rate factor of 2.10 shall be applied to the uniform mill rate for all commercial and industrial classes of property in the Town of Lampman.
- 4. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final passing thereof.
- 5. Bylaw No. 2022-6 is hereby repealed.
